



General Program Information

Early Eagle Academy is a childcare program targeted for children ages 3-5. The program focuses on building school-readiness skills in a playful environment. Program goals include the following:

- To provide early learners and their families with knowledge, resources and materials to aid in kindergarten readiness.
- To encourage the educational and professional development of families to broaden each child's base of support.

The Early Eagle Academy childcare sites include (dependent upon state licensure):

- Fancy Farm Elementary
- Farmington Elementary
- Graves County Middle School
- Symsonia Elementary
- Wingo Elementary

The program will operate on a year-round basis and provide full-day, full-week childcare (Monday-Friday; 7:00 a.m.-5:30 p.m.). Part-time childcare for our current Graves County preschool students will also be offered as a "wrap-around" program to assist working families. In addition, drop-in/emergency care services will be offered if space is available. Tuition for these services are:

- Full-time \$125/ per week
- Part-time \$75/ per week
- Drop-In/Emergency \$30/ per day

There will be a \$50 registration fee that will be collected each year to assist in classroom supplies. Please make this payment when registering your child for the program. Each child will also be responsible for providing the following:

- Youth-sized backpack (large enough for a folder)
- Plastic pocket folder
- Change of clothes labeled in a Ziplock bag

A full description of program information including arrival/departure procedures, safety and health management procedures, center policies, curriculum and assessment, and behavior management practices will be included in the *Parent Handbook* that will be given during the program orientation prior to the first day of operation.
