The Central Elementary SBDM Council met on December 19, 2016. Members present were: Chairman Stephanie Sullivan, Vice-Chairman Keri Cornwell, parent, Sammy Beck, and teachers, Diane Janes and Stephanie West. Guests included Assistant Principal, Alecia Ladd.

1. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stephanie Sullivan.
2. Sammy Beck made a motion that the agenda be approved. Diane Janes seconded and motion passed.
3. Minutes from the November 15, 2016 Site Base meeting were read and approved with Keri Cornwell motioning and Sammy Beck seconding the motion.
4. Old Business:
 - A. SBDM Emergency Management Plan Policy: Mrs. Sullivan presented a draft SBDM policy. Sammy Beck moved that the council approve the policy as written. Keri Cornwell seconded and the motion passed. Members signed and dated the new policy.
5. New Business:
 - A. KAGEN Training: Mrs. Sullivan explained to the council that Central has an opportunity to be a host school for two days of KAGEN Training this summer. She informed the council that she would like for most of the certified staff and some of the classified staff to receive the training. Therefore it would be more economical for us to host the training than to pay over \$200 for each Central staff member to attend the training at another site. She went on to explain that because of changes in our Math and Reading intervention programs, more Professional Development funds will be available for the next school year. Keri Cornwell motioned to approve the two days of Professional Development as presented and Diane Janes seconded. Motion carried.
 - B. Program Review Assurances: Council members signed the assurance statement documenting that foundational elements have been reviewed by school staff and are either in place or have been identified as areas of growth for the 2016-17 school year.
